11. Routes of entry to membership

One can receive a title of The Certified Real Estate Appraiser, of China, only upon passing The National Qualifying Examination for the Real Estate Appraisers. And the Examination can only be taken by those who hold a bachelor's degree or higher academic achievement and have at least two years' working experience in the relevant field and recognized position.

Academic training programs are available in universities and academic institutions in China.

An aggregate of no less than 32-hours of Continuing Professional Development has to be taken by every member in any 3-year period after he has been duly qualified and registered as member of the institute.

14. Statutory recognition

According to the Urban Real Estate Administration Law of the People's Republic of China and the Administrative Permission Law of the People's Republic of China, real estate appraisal works are only be carried out by registered real estate appraisers. All members of CIREA are qualified to carry out real estate appraisals in China under such legislations.

Real estate appraisers are qualified to carry out valuations of all type of properties: industrial, commercial, office and residential, and for all types of purposes: purchase, sale, letting, investment, mortgage, insurance and compensation. Their works have to follow the Code of Practice for Real Estate Appraisal promulgated by the Institute and comply with some guidelines issued by the Ministry of Construction of the People's Republic of China.
