The Task Force has organised a special session in the technical programme at the Congress. Over the past six months the Task Force has published a news item each month with focus on a commission or network chair and their approach to the SDG's. With this work done, and still more areas to focus on in regard to FIG and the SDG's the Task Force recommends that the Task Force will continue during the next term. Task Force on FIG and the Sustainable Development Goals

The 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development provides us the road towards a sustainable world. We are now in the decade of action. There is a sense of urgency. We are the generation to end extreme poverty and to address climate change, injustice and gender inequality. We all have to take action, individually, collectively, locally and globally.

Also FIG has a responsibility towards the SDGs. At the General Assembly, during the FIG Working Week in Hanoi, the council established the Task Force on FIG and the Sustainable Development Goals. The developments in the past years related to health, climate change, conflict, migration show the need to transform our world into a more sustainable environment. The pressure on land and sea is urgent and requires faster and at the same time sustainable solutions by national and local governments and for citizens and society.

Within FIG members and delegates are motivated to push boundaries and to address the challenges to make our world a better place. The FIG Task Force support FIG in it's responsibility to:

- Raise awareness on the relevance of the SDGs and the indicators for the FIG, the commissions and the delegates
- Contribute to the achievement of the SDGs
- Facilitate discussions to deliver (meta) data enabling SDG-related performance to be measured

The aim of the Task Force

Since the establishment of the Task Force the following results have been achieved:

- Identified the relevant SDGs for FIG and its commissions
- Raise awareness of the importance of the SDGs for FIG, the commissions and Member Associations during events
- Inform & Inspire FIG Community on SDGs on FIG website and FIG Communication channels
- Alignment with other global initiatives with UNGGIM and GLTN

Activities of the Task Force 2019 - 2022

In the last 3 years several activities were executed by the Task Force. Due to the impact of the pandemic, the character of the activities changed. As well as the impact.

Ensured that SDGs were included as (sub) themes for the FIG Working Week

For both the FIG Working Week in 2020 as the FIG e-Working week the SDG's were one of the subthemes. By doing so the SDG's were one of the 3 read threads throughout the event.

- Each subtheme was linked to a dedicated Conference day
- Keynote sessions were linked to one of the subthemes
- Each commission meeting was linked to one of the subthemes
- Red thread in the communication before, during and after the events

The focus on the SDG's contributed to increased awareness among the participants about the role of FIG and themselves towards the SDG's.
