Background of FIG Young Surveyors Network Asia and the Pacific (YSNAP)

During the 2nd FIG Young Surveyors Conference, held during the XXV FIG Congress in 2014 in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, the FIG Young Surveyors Asia and the Pacific Network (YSNAP) was established.

The first YSNAP Meeting was held on the final day of the XXV FIG Congress and end of the 2nd Young Surveyors Conference. In total 18 from 45 countries were represented and after each individual country report, and a forum discussion the goals for the Asian Pacific network were identified. These are:



- 1. Strengthen and grow the Asia and Pacific Network
- 2. Identify opportunities for collaborative events in the region
- 3. Establish a regional social media platform on <u>Facebook</u>
- 4. Capacity development of Young Surveyors focusing on challenges in the Asia Pacific Region
- 5. Exploring funding opportunities to support the events organised by the YSNAP

Since the establishment of the YSNAP in 2014 the region has strengthened and collaborated to focus on the challenges facing the region.

Highlights from the last 7 years include:

- 3rd Young Surveyors Conference in Christchurch in 2016
- Launch of the FIG YSN Volunteer Community Surveyor Program with work being completed in Nepal in 2017.
- Japan Young Surveyors hosting their first meeting, STDM Training, and the 2nd YSNAP Meeting in June 2018.
- Survey and Spatial New Zealand Young Professionals coordinated a Volunteering Toolkit Workshop.
- 3rd FIG Young Surveyors Network Asia and the Pacific Meeting (3YSAPM) held in Hanoi, Vietnam in April 2019
- The Southeast Asian Survey Congress (SEASC) in Darwin, Northern Territory, Australia hosted by the SSSI Young Professionals Network in August 2019.



4th Young Surveyors Network Asia and the Pacific Regional Meeting (4YSAPM)

Summary

The 4th FIG Young Surveyors Network - Asia and the Pacific Meeting (4YSAPM) will be held from the 8 – 10 November 2023 in Seoul, South Korea. The theme for the meeting - "Geo-Revolution, Better Life for All", is consistent with the overall theme of the Smart GEO Expo 2023: "Digital Earth, Better Life for All." Young surveyors stand at the nexus of the rise of smart technologies. They therefore stand as the drivers of these new approaches to use these technologies to meet the societal needs especially with the environment.

This year, the YSNAP see the need for this and taking advantage of the Smart GEO Expo 2023, the YSAP is organising its fourth meeting to further explore this theme within the scope of the young surveyor. The three-day meeting will cover issues relating to the above theme, as well as a Cultural Tour.

Day 1 - Geo-Revolution, Better Life for All

The first day of the meeting will start by the welcoming addresses from distinguished guests from FIG, FIG Foundation, and the FIG Young Surveyors Network. These welcoming and associated presentations will set the agenda for the three-day meeting and focus on the theme 'Digital Earth, Better Life for All.' Afterwards, participants will join in the opening Ceremonies & Exhibition Tour of 2023 Smart GEO Expo. A Speed Dating Networking will be hosted by the YSNAP during the luncheon.

The afternoon activities comprise two (2) sessions -

The first session, under the heading, *"Tech-Talk! – Geo-solution Presentations"*. This session provides an engaging platform and immersive learning experience to its diverse audience to help shape the future of geospatial technologies. It is a platform for prominent industry players to present their latest geo-solutions and make sure they reach a wide network of peers.

The second session "Youth Talk! – Digital Earth, Better Life for All". This session will be a balance between experienced Surveyors and Young Surveyors from the Asia Pacific Region sharing their perspective on Digital Earth, Better Life for All. At the end of the session, there will be a panel discussion focusing on how Young Surveyors & Young Professionals can contribute their knowledge and skills, in some way, for the betterment of the surveying profession.

Day 2 – Drone Operations and Shaping the Future for YSNAP Regional Network

The second day of the meeting will start by participating in the 2023 Smart GEO Expo sessions particularly on "Introduction of The Government of Korea (GOK)'s Official Development Assistance (ODA) cases"





The second and third session will be about "The use of Drones in various fields and their prospects" and "Drone Operation Practice: Practice Method and Technique" respectively. The use of Unmanned Aerial Vehicles (UAVs) has surged in the last two decades, making them popular instruments for a wide range of applications, and leading to a remarkable number of scientific contributions in geoscience, remote sensing, and engineering. The sessions will provide attendees with a detailed discussion reviews the current trends and best practices for the use of UAVs for survey and mapping applications.

The fourth and last session "Let's shape our Future! – YSN AP Discussion" will be a session designed to discuss shaping the YSN Asia and the Pacific Network. Answering the question, "Where do we go from here?" This will be a region-specific goal setting session set to record our goals and objectives for the future of YSNAP Regional Network!

Day 3 – Excursion and Cultural Exploration – the Seoul Experience

The third day will be dedicated to a whole day of excursion and cultural visits in selected museums and famous places in Seoul, South Korea. Social Activity that will provide a memorable experience for all attendees, as we end the meeting on the third day.

Rationale

Rapid changes in land use associated with economic development, urbanization, and the need to feed a rapidly growing population have significantly increased demand for policies and systems that can help guide proper land management, land use and the land related services. In developing countries, poorly managed processes of land and the lack of clarity on land rights have long been the major issues that hamper economic development. It is more and more evident that developing countries need to have functioning land administration system and clear policies on land.

Korea has gone through rapid industrialization through powerful government-led economic development policies since the 1960s. Rapid industrialization and urbanization resulted in large-scale migration of rural populations to cities as well as various land use and development projects such as urban development, industrial complex developments, and express way/railroad/harbor developments.

In the process, there have been so many land-related affairs that the government has to deal with. Land and housing prices increased, and land price speculation was common and land sprawl is a serious issue in growing cities. Accordingly, the government introduced various land policies such as the public development system, real estate taxation, development impact fees system, and development permission system to solve problems of land speculation.

Land-related affairs included a wide range of areas such as policy, possession, transaction, use control, development, and management. The central government would entrust local governments for most land-related matters except establishing land policies. However, the central government had difficulties in collecting information on land policies accurately, frequently failing to cope with land-related problems in a timely manner. Local governments were also struggling with heavy workloads of handling hundreds of thousands of land-related civil complaints every year. In this context, there have been strong complaints from the citizens in getting the correct land related information, and there are many corruption cases in handing land affairs. Against this background, the Government developed an integrated land information system and has been able to remove room for injustice and corruption in handling land-related affairs successfully.
