- Social protective programs house insurance mandatory?




3. What is the bright side, though?

Individual knowledge concerning natural hazards and calamities is generally educed. Increased knowledge is positively associated with perceived seriousness of threat.

ssue salient → better response to protective measures.

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- Crisis intervention
 - assist people in regaining autonomous functioning



- Psychological First- Aid
 - people with no psychotherapy practice can provide relief and support to disaster- struck communities
- Psycho-education
 - help people respond in proactive and efficient manner
