### **Effect of Covid**

On Profession

- We had near to no teleworking in Luxembourg before the Covid in the profession.
- We had a few test candidates at the Cadaster Administration.
- Experiences of this test phase should lead to a new law concerning teleworking. Covid accelerated this process.

- Meetings, conferences went online.
- The workload dropped during the first shutdown but caught up fast later.
- In Luxembourg housebuilding is booming, the demand for surveying operations stayed high across the Covid time.

### In the schools:

- Surveyors present the profession for the last two study years of students of the lycées (secondary schools) to orient them for further studies. This takes place twice a year and has motivates every five years two to three surveyors.
- We have presented the profession at the secondary school, specializing on the building professions with practical exercises.

- Once a year the OLG has a showcase at the national student fair organized by the Ministry of Education.
- Universities from Europe and abroad present themselves.
- Administrations, Associations (like OLG) and professions present their profiles.
- The OLG collaborates at this fair with the OAI, Ordre des Architectes et Ingénieurs. The OAI has a much higher budget than the OAI and permits a better visibility to the OLG.
